



## **Deliveries**

To Murray Street Mall are to be made from the City of Perth's Forrest Place Loading Dock.

To Hay Street Mall are to be made from the enex100 Loading Dock.

# Deliveries to private properties in the malls

Access to Private Properties in the Malls must be requested by the owner of the property, or their agent(s), with all details adhered to. If the owner gives consent for access to their property, they will pass the information of the vehicle/driver to this office via the Malls Access Permit Application form.

## 2 Working days must be given

If the owner refuses access to their property, enquires should revert to the City of Perth Customer Experience Team for alternative arrangements.

# The following conditions apply for shop fit-outs, maintenance and service vehicles

- Vehicles used for unloading materials / goods for shop fit-outs but are not required to do the job must leave the Mall by 0600hrs. Driver(s) must substantiate the requirement for their vehicles to remain in the Mall prior to any permission be granted.
- 2. Due to the changes in trading times, shop fitouts, re-fits, maintenance etc. which require you to have your vehicles at hand in Murray St Mall / Hay St Mall, must now be done between 2130hrs and 0600hrs Monday-Thursday, Friday between 2230hrs and 0600hrs and Saturday / Sunday between 1800hrs and 0900hrs. This includes delivery of materials and the initial stock delivery.

- 3. Late requests, time changes or additional vehicles made with less than 24hrs notice may not be approved.
- 4. No more than three (3) vehicles are allowed in the Mall at any given time.
- 5. This permission is valid for a five (5) period only. (Special circumstances may be requested not necessarily approved).
- 6. Should the driver be requested to remove their vehicle from the Malls by a City of Perth staff member and fail to comply, they will be issued with an infringement notice.

# Entrance to Hay and Murray Street Malls

Murray Street Mall is strictly one-way traffic flow from West to East (enter off William Street) Hay Street Mall is strictly one-way traffic flow from East to West (enter off Barrack Street)

Please note: access to the malls must be made via the bollard telecom system. Authorised vehicles entering the malls by any other means will be issued with an infringement notice of \$125 for failure to comply with conditions of a permit.

There is strictly no vehicular movement through the malls between the following times:

1200hrs (noon) – 1400hrs (2pm) 1700hrs (5pm) – 1800hrs (6pm)

### Exceptions on Fridays:

1200hrs (noon) – 1400hrs(2pm) 1700hrs (5pm) – 2300hrs (11pm)

### Exceptions on Weekends

0900hrs (9am) – 1800hrs (6pm) Saturday 1100hrs (11am) – 1700hrs (5pm) Sunday
